JOB GOALS

- 1. To assist English Learners (EL) in the acquisition of listening, speaking, reading, and writing of the English language
- 2. To support the Mission and Beliefs of the District when carrying out duties and responsibilities as assigned

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Typical duties and responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Provides English instruction to English Learners (EL) in grades Pre-K through 12
- 2. Guide English Learners toward gaining proficiency in listening, speaking, reading and writing of the English language
- 3. Assist in administering required language proficiency and academic achievement tests for determining placement and ongoing monitoring of student progress
- 4. Assist in developing language acquisition support plans for all EL students and work with classroom teachers to implement plans
- 5. Assist in developing appropriate curriculum to help EL students with English language acquisition
- 6. Establish and maintain communication with parents of students in the EL program
- 7. Work with classroom teachers to support differential instruction

- 8. Attend professional development trainings and stay abreast of laws and legal obligations of the district
- 9. Perform other duties as assigned

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT

Employment is based upon identified need; may be up to 180 days annually, with stipend as approved by the Board of Trustees
