

TITLE: IN- SCHOOL SUSPENSION AIDE/ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM AIDE

REPORTS TO: Principal/Alternative Program Coordinator

JOB GOAL: To supervise students in In-School Suspension for disciplinary reasons and/or Alternate Program. Maintain a highly structured and orderly environment.

JOB TASKS AND PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

- 1. Work with certified teacher and campus administrators to create and maintain an orderly and highly structured classroom environment.
- 2. Work with individual students to complete assignments given by classroom teacher.
- 3. Consult classroom teachers regarding student assignments.
- 4. Distribute, collect, and check student assignments for accuracy.
- 5. Maintain individual files and completed student assignments and return to classroom teachers.
- 6. Manage student behavior and administer discipline according to board policies, administrative regulations, and Individual Education Plans (IEP)
- 7. Record student attendance and discipline referrals using personal computer.
- 8. Supervise students assigned to ISS during luch and bathroom breaks.
- 9. Maintain confidentiality.
- 10. Partipate in staff development training programs, faculty meetings, and special events as assigned.
- 11. Staff may be required to perform duties before or after school including: assisting with drop off and pick up of students by parents or by bus; monitoring students in the cafeteria, library, or gym; and tutoring students who are at-risk or need additional instruction.
